





COMMUNICATIONS IN DISTRICT 103

Websites

- On these homepages, you can locate quick link icons that launch other important sources of information, including:
 - **Virtual Backpack**, a webpage with postings and informational flyers about programs and happenings at District 103, Daniel Wright, Half Day, Laura Sprague and our community. 
 - **Student Information System**, a tool for insight to the academic progress of your child and access to student report cards, demographic and attendance information. Our district uses **PowerSchool** for registration and student records. 

- The homepages also provide online calendars and timely news posts about student accomplishments, activities, programs and events at our schools. We update them frequently with news entries and post informational flyers daily. **Subscriptions to our calendars and news posts** are great ways to stay up to date on what's happening at your child's school and across the district!
 - **Subscribe to Calendars**
Locate our online calendars on our district and school homepages for timely information about activities, programs and events at our schools. Our homepages offer the option to "Subscribe to Calendars." Simply select the related icon on the homepage, register an account using your email address, and customize your calendar subscriptions. If you have already subscribed to our calendars, remember to review and update your settings for the new school year. 
 - **Subscribe to News Lists**
We update the homepages frequently with news, and you can subscribe to receive our news posts. Select the related icon on the homepage, register an account and customize your news feeds by interest group. You can choose from e-mail, SMS or RSS options to receive the news feeds. If you choose RSS, you will need an RSS reader that is compatible with your device. If you have already subscribed to our news posts, remember to review and update your settings for the new school year.

Announcements & Publications

- We also frequently publish eNewsletters for each school and the district. These electronic newsletters are delivered frequently to families by e-mail and are also posted to our websites. - Each year, the District publishes an *Annual Report* with test score and financial reporting information, as well as specific comparable financial and performance metrics. We also post it to the District web site, and send it electronically to subscribers.
- The District annually publishes **Parent-Student Handbooks** with information on regulations, an explanation of the services we provide, as well as our expectations for the education of District 103 students. The handbooks are intended to provide a summary of Board policies and procedures governing the District, describe the *1:1 Teaching & Learning Initiative*, and may be amended during the year.
