A Bill to Mandate that Chips for Children be Available to All Citizens

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- 1. **SECTION 1**. GPS chips similar to those inserted into pets will be available for children.
- 2. **SECTION 2.** A. Any parent or guardian wishing to have a GPS chip inserted into their
- 3. child aged one year or older may do so.
- 4. B. Chips will be covered by individual's health insurance and free to families.
- 5. C. Chips will be inserted in different locations on children to ensure that they will not
- 6. be removed involuntarily.
- 7. D. Beginning at age eighteen, chipped children can choose to have the chip removed.
- 8. **SECTION 3.** The Department of
- 9. Health and Human Services will be in charge of the workings of this bill.
- 10. **SECTION 4.** The provisions of this bill will go into effect on January 1, 2018.
- 11. **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
