The tryouts consist of a paper test given **after school in Room 110 on Wednesday, September 21.** Students who advance will be observed on the buzzer and a select team of five students will be chosen. A second team will be selected to practice with the varsity team. The ability to push a buzzer and wait to be recognized is the buzzer skill. Scholastic Bowl also uses this skill. The Science Bowl team practices at DW on Wednesdays after school in Room 110 and will be dismissed in time for the P.A.S.S. bus. More practices will be scheduled closer to the regional competition.

Students must be available to participate at the regional academic competition on a Saturday in February to be determined, the regional car competition typically on a Saturday in March, and at the National Science Bowl in Washington D.C. on April 27 – May 1, 2017. Only the team who wins first place at the regional academic competition will be invited to participate at the national tournament.
