- * On the next screen, select: **Grade 5 & 6 Game Club – Mr. Beno**
- * The next screen describes the activity, date, time, location, and cost. At this screen, click to Register for the Class.
- * The next screen will list the web store "account holder" as a participant. You will need to select the "Add Participant" box in order to add your child as a participant in the activity. Please enter the requested information for your child, and select Add Participant.
You should then see the child listed as a potential participant. Choose the button next to your child's name.
- * Indicate permission for your child to participate in the activity by selecting the box under Permission Agreement (required step).
- * Select "Checkout."
- * Make a secure payment for the activity using a credit card (Visa, MasterCard, Discover).

After completion of the payment you will receive a receipt via email, which you can use as a reminder about the event.
